



Cheetah Facts

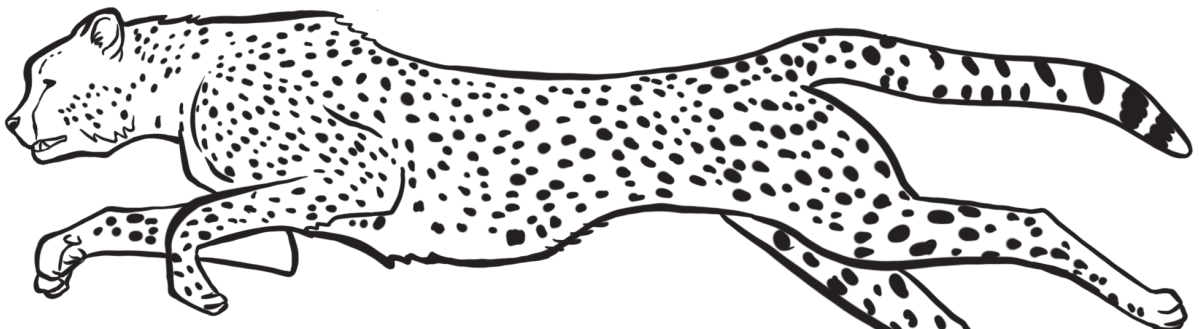
- A cheetah doesn't retract its claws when running—rather uses them like cleats to grab the ground.
