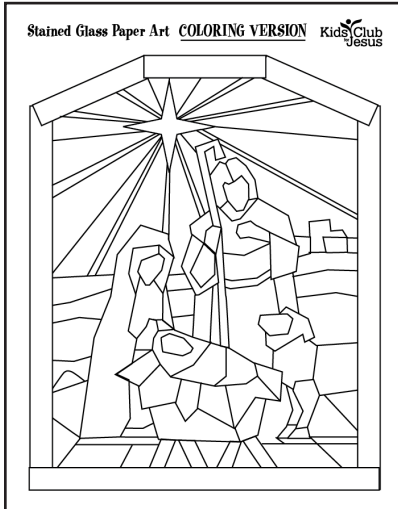


Stained Glass Paper Art

COLORING VERSION

ITEMS NEEDED:

- Print out the coloring version page. (If you don't have a printer center the image on your computer screen and trace the image to the paper.)
- colored pencils, crayons, markers, etc.
- scissors
- string or yarn
- tape
- popsicle/craft sticks or small sticks (optional)
- glue (optional)

DIRECTIONS:

Step 1: For the coloring version—color the different sections of the stained glass art however you want.

Step 2: Cut out the image.

Step 3: (optional) Use popsicle sticks, craft sticks or even regular wood sticks to make the frame for the picture by gluing them around the edge of the finished colored art.

Step 4: Attach the string to top of the wood frame and hang it in a window or on the wall. Share it with a friend or family member.
